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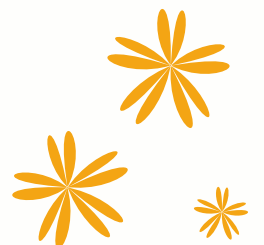
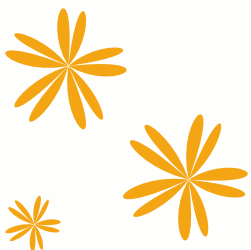

በ2013፤ በማህበረሰባችን ውስጥ እገዛ እና ፍቅር ለሚያስፈልጋቸው ቀላል የማይባሉ ሰዎች በትክክለኛ ግዜ እንደአቅማችን ትክክለኛ እገዛ እንዳደረግን ቢሰማንም፤ በአካባቢያችን ካለው ዘርፈ ብዙ ተግዳሮቶች አንጻር የኛ ስራ "ባህርን በጭልፍ" እንደመሞከር መሆኑን እንገነዘባለን። ነገር ግን፤ በFICDO ስኬትን በቁጥሮች እና በጥርጣሬ አንመዘንም። ስራችን የመልካም ሰዎችን እና የማህበረሰቡን ልብ ለብ ስራ የሚቀሰቅስ፤ የአመለካከትና የአስተሳሰብ ለውጥ ላይ በጎ ተጽእኖ የሚፈጥር ነው ብለን እናምናለን። የ2013ን የስራ እንቅስቃሴ ስንገመግም፤ ይህን ከግምት ውስጥ በማስገባት እንጂ፤ የምናሳየው የተገነባ ህንጻ፤ የሚቆረጥ ረባባ እንዳልሆነ እንባቢ እንዲረዳልን እንወዳለን። ይልቁንም፤ የበጎ ፈቃድ አገልጋዮቻችን እና ለጋሾቻችን የራሳቸውን ነገርና የቤታቸውን ቀዳዳ ወደ ጎን ትተው ለሌሎች ለመድረስ ያደረጉት ጥረት ብዙዎችን ያነቃቃል ብለን ተስፋ እናደርጋለን። የ2013 ስራችን፤ ብንተባበር ምን ማድረግ እንደምንችል ማሳያ፤ ለራሳችን የማናንስ እና የሌሎችን እጅ መጠበቅ እንደሌለብን እንደ ማንቅያ ትንሽ ምሳሌ እንዲወሰድ እንፈልጋለን። በተጨማሪም FICDO ከሚንቀሳቀስበት አካባቢ ጋር ምንም አይነት ግንኙነት የሌላቸው ብዙ መልካም ሰዎች ካላቸው ቆርሰው ከኛ ጋር ማካፈላቸው፤ ከዝያ ማህበረሰብ ለወጣን ምሳሌ የሚሆን፤ የበለጠ ቁጭትና መነቃቃት የሚያመጣ፤ ልዩነቶቻችንን ከመቁጠር ይልቅ በጋራ ነገሮቻችን ላይ በአንድነት እንድንሰራ የሚያደርግ ነው ብለን እናምናለን። ፈጣሪ ቢፈቅድ አብረን የበለጠ እንሰራለን።

A BRIEF HISTORY ABOUT THE FOUNDING OF FICDO

At the end of 2017, Ewnetu Ermias, an IT professional took a career break to pursue a volunteering opportunity in Ethiopia. This experience spurred his desire for change, resulting in the founding of FICDO.

Ewnetu's volunteering experience commenced in his home town of Fitcha, central Ethiopia when he returned as a volunteer after two decades of living in Europe. He observed that not much had changed in his home town. Despite the abundance of natural and human resources, poverty is still rampant. Many vulnerable elderly are not only poverty stricken but also suffer from loneliness. Young girls and boys are not attending school for lack of basic resources. In most cases, children as young as seven and eight have to work to support their guardians or other family members. Ewnetu admits that what he saw was not new to him as he grew up in poverty himself. "But," he recalls, "my parents sacrificed everything and gave me an opportunity to go to school". He knows what it means to get an opportunity.

Ewnetu realized that the situation on the ground was overwhelmingly challenging, but he also believed that small hope-filled acts of kindness could improve people's lives. Hence, he started engaging with like-minded people, visiting the most marginalized within the community, the elderly. This kick-started an informal "befriending" service which caught the attention of others in the community. Ewnetu recalls, "...wherever we went and started speaking about poverty in our community, we saw a strong support and willingness to change the status-quo". It seemed many people were aware of the social and economic challenges but did not know how to respond as an individual. However, this is not to say that there were no naysayers. Discouraged by past negative experiences and failed efforts, some were cautious about the new initiative.

Throughout the first half of 2019, the small group who were determined to see change pushed forward and built relationships with community members in Addis, who have been informally organised for a similar cause. In June 2019, a non-profit organisation called FICDO (*Fikir* Integrated Community Development Organisation) was formed and registered. The organisation is completely volunteer-led and run by local community members.

FICDO's core belief is that, with proper support and an enabling environment every community has what it takes to transform and flourish. The goal, therefore, is to embed mutual caring into the everyday life of the community. After all, for transformation to be sustainable, it has to come from within and be embraced by the community.

የFICDO ምስረታ መነሻው በመስከረም 2011 አቶ እውነቱ ለበጎ ፈቃድ ስራ ወደ ትውልድ ስፍራቸው ከመምጣት ጋር የተያያዘ ቢሆንም፤ በአዲስ አበባ የሚገኙ የአካባቢው ተወላጆች ሃሳቡ እውን እንዲሆን ከፍተኛ ርብርብ አድርገዋል። ድርጅቱ ከመመስረቱ በፊት፤ ካለፈባቸው ፈተናዎች አንዱና ዋናው "ከዚህ ቀደም ተጀምረው በአጭር እንደቀሩት፤ ይህም የትም አይደርስም" የሚል አመለካከት ያላቸው ሰዎች መኖራቸው ነበር። ነገር ግን፤ ባለፉት ነገሮች ተስፋ ሳይቆርጡ "የቻልነውን እናደርጋለን" ብለው የተነሱ ሰዎች ድርጅቱ እንዲመሰረት ትልቅ ምክንያት ሆነዋል። ዛሬ ይህ ከድርጅታችን ታሪክ ጋር እንዲታወስ የምንፈልገው፤ ስራውን የሚሰራውም ሆነ የሚሰራለት ማህበረሰባችን በመሆኑ፤ የድርጅቱ ህልውና ከማህበረሰባችን ድጋፍ ጋር የተያያዘ እንደሆነ ለማስመር ነው።

ABOUT FICDO'S EDUCATION PROGRAM

ጥቂት ስለትምህርት ፕሮግራሞችን

Several children in developing countries must start working from a young age to support themselves and/or even, at times, other family members. Hence they don't go to school. This is no different in the community that FICDO serves. Therefore, one of FICDO's strategic objectives is supporting such children with their basic needs (including food) and ensuring their education. However, feeding several children on a daily basis for an organisation with a meager budget is challenging. Therefore, as done in the previous year, we sought local solutions for these local problems; i.e. pooling every resource in the community to drive the cost low:

- The local authority donated an old building, which we use for storage and dining
- The local authority donated firewood for cooking
- We built a make-shift kitchen
- Two cooks were hired to prepare meals
- We source cheap ingredients locally
- Volunteers run the day to day activities
- Children get meals (breakfast and lunch) before heading to school



We also provide school uniforms, footwear and school supplies for the children.

ሃገራችንን ጨምሮ በብዙ ታዳጊ አገሮች፤ ብዙ ህጻናት እንደሌሎች እድሜ እኩዮቻቸው ትምህርት ቤት ከመዋል ይልቅ የእለት ገርስ ፍለጋ ይባዛሉ። የFICDO አንዱ አላማ ህብረተሰቡን እና ቅን ልብ ያላቸውን ሁሉ በማስተባበር ለእንደነዚህ ልጆች የትምህርት እድል እንዲያገኙ ሁኔታዎችን (ምግብ ማግኘትን ጨምሮ) ማመቻቸት ነው። ነገር ግን በጥቂት ቅን ግለሰቦች እርዳታ የሚሰራ ድርጅት ቀርቶ ለሌላውም በየቀኑ ህጻናትን ምግብ ማብላት የማይታሰብ ነው። ለፈጣሪ ምስጋና ይግባውና፤ ይህ ችግር ሳያቆመን፤ የአካባቢያችንን ችግር ለራሳችን መፍትሄ በማበጀት ልክ እንደ 2012 ባሳለፍነው አመትም ያሰብነው ተሳክቶልን ልጆቻችንን መግባናል።

- ማገዶ እና መመገብያ ስፍራ የፍቼ 02 ቀበሌ በነጻ ሰጠን
- ይህን ሁሉ የበጎ ፈቃድ ሰራተኞቻችን ያለመስልቸት በነጻ ይሰራሉ
- ህጻናት ቁርስና ምሳ በልተው ወደትምህርታቸው ያለሃሳብ ይሄዳሉ
- አቅም ለሌላቸው አረጋግጫንም ከዚህ ምሳ እንቋጥራለን
- እግዚአብሔር ስራውን ባረከው፤ጸጋም አበዛልን

FICDO's Education Program supports children from disadvantaged families. Of these, more than half are either raised by single parents or close relatives who have little or no disposable income of their own. One or both of parents of 25% of the children have absconded (mostly due to mental illness). The Program not only ensures the children's future through education, but also provides much needed daily meals required for their survival. Thank you for being our partners in changing lives.

MAKING THE BEST USE OF LOCAL RESOURCES

"የሃገሩን ስርዶ በሃገሩ በሬ"

One of the greatest aspects of FICDO's community initiative is that we make the best use of local resources. Fitch Town administration donated to FICDO, a building previously used as a class room for pre-school children. The building has chairs and tables and is perfect to seat the children during meals. However, it lacked sufficient space for cooking. Undeterred by this challenge, our hardworking volunteers rose up to the occasion and sought to resolve the issue by constructing a makeshift kitchen in a small space behind the building. Within a few days, the kitchen was ready for use. Our volunteers also collect and recycle anything they get their hands on including worn furniture shown on the left hand side. Nothing is put to waste by this resourceful team!

We are grateful to our volunteers for their care and love for these children, and to our donors and friends for supporting this worthy cause.

The environment in which many of our children are growing is harsh. But we are sowing seeds of hope, by faith, that our small actions would bear fruit. By investing on the children's education, we are investing in their future. We are exercising pro-active care. We hope that the children break out of the crushing poverty that has had weighed down on their parents and generations before them.

ብዙ የማህበረሰባችን ልጆች እጅግ አስቸጋሪ ወይም ህይወት ይወለዳሉ፤ ከእድሜያቸው በላይ በሆነ መከራ ውስጥ ያልፋሉ። በዚህ አስቸጋሪ ሁኔታ ውስጥ በእምነት እና በተስፋ ዘር እንደሚሰጡ። ይህ ዘር አንድ ቀን በቅላ ታፈራለች በሚል ተስፋ። ልጆች የትምህርት እድል እንዲያገኙ የተቻለንን ሁሉ የምናደርገው፤ የወደፊት ኑሮአቸው እንዲሻሻልና ቤተሰቦቻቸውን እና የቀደመውን ትውልድ ካሳበጠው ድህነት ቀንበር እንዲለቀቁ ነው። ትውልድን ከድህነት እናስመልጥ።

MSW is seven. Her father passed away when she was one. Her mother is visually impaired and lives off street begging. For MSW and her siblings, attending school is unthinkable since getting a daily meal is a priority. Hence, MSW's elder sister is working as daily labourer to supplement the family income. MSW's fate would not be any different.

Thanks to FICDO's education program, MSW has been enrolled in a nearby primary school since last year. FICDO covered her expenses including school materials and a uniform. Above all, she gets two meals a day from our feeding program. She is now in 1st class and thriving.

FROM EUROPE WITH LOVE

Shem Romanowiski is originally from Poland. He now lives and works in Dublin, Ireland. Shem has been our monthly supporter of FICDO's Education Program for over a year. We convinced Shem that his story will inspire our readers and supporters. So he kindly agreed for an email interview. Nuhamin Ermias has compiled his responses as follows:



FICDO: How did you hear about FICDO?

Shem: I first heard about FICDO from Ewnetu about a year and half ago (winter 2019/2020) when we were volunteering for a charity in Dublin. Ewnetu told me about FICDO and its social inclusion projects supporting communities in central Ethiopia, especially children by providing breakfast and lunch as well as school materials and uniforms. As I am already a project coordinator with another organisation providing social inclusion projects to immigrants in Ireland, I immediately let Ewnetu know I wanted to get involved with FICDO.

FICDO: What made you decide to reach out to children in Ethiopia through FICDO?

Shem: I am originally from Poland and arrived in Ireland in 2004 in search of a better life. I experienced difficulties in accessing jobs in Dublin because I didn't have a good education. Through my personal experience, I can say that education improves lives, broadens horizons and brings wealth and progress to the individual, his/her family as well as to the community. I always wanted to support children in an African country by helping a small, grassroot organisation. With this in mind, FICDO became the organisation of my choice and I am delighted to be able to support children in central Ethiopia.

FICDO: Your support not only ensures the wellbeing of a child through provision of basic daily meals but also gives educational opportunities for children to break out of poverty. How does that make you feel/affect you?

Shem: As mentioned above, I truly believe the only way out of poverty is through education. Knowing that there would be a child that will receive an opportunity for education is very important to me and I am glad I can support FICDO in its effort to deliver this promise to children that it serves.

FICDO: How do you know that your money is well-spent (goes to the right place)?

Shem: I was reassured by Ewnetu that donated money are spent directly in the community. Also, there is an annual newsletter as well as Ewnetu's posts and updates on Facebook where I can inform myself about the developments of the project. But also, it would be great to know more about the children that receive support; their names, their family circumstances etc. That way closer ties could be established.*

FICDO: Any message for the community and the children that you are supporting?

Shem: I just hope the children avail of every opportunity to learn and discover. Never stop dreaming and be brave! I hope to see you very soon!

*Note from FICDO: All donations go to services we provide for children and elderlies under our care. We have no overhead costs as we are volunteer run and have no paid staff so far. Since some of the services that we provide are labor intensive, our volunteers dedicate their times exclusively on those. Lack of resources means we do not have dedicated staff and social workers who could facilitate/manage sponsor-child interactions on a regular basis. Resources permitting, we intend to move in that direction in the near future. For the time being, we use social media and e-zines to update our supporters.

ABOUT SOUL-2-SOUL PROGRAM

ጥቂት ስለ "ፍቅር ለአረጋዊያን" ፕሮግራሞችን

Millions of men and women who are engaged in casual and unpredictable employment for all of their adult life are less likely to have pensions or savings in their old age. Usually, extended family members support such elderly persons. However, those who have no close family often live in dire conditions. In addition to material poverty, the elderly can also suffer from loneliness. FICDO's *SOUL-2-SOUL* program is designed to address these issues:

- We strive to mobilise the community to befriend elderlies who have no family. The idea is connecting one person to another, hence we named the program *SOUL-2-SOUL*.
- We also strive to connect those who have limited or no income, and struggle to get daily meals for survival, with sponsors who may support them with their financial needs. For those who have no sponsor, we try to provide small monthly cash supplements.
- For those with mobility issues due to ill-health and old age, who may not be able to prepare meals for themselves, we do our best to bring packed lunch (usually from the little excess at the school feeding program that we are running).
- We do community sensitization and advocacy, highlighting not only issues the elderly are facing but also the fact that they deserve a life of dignity

- አስታዋሽ የሌላቸው አንድ አረጋዊ፤ በወር አንድ ቀን እንኳን ግማሽ ሰአት ሰጥቶ የሚሰጋቸው እና የሚያዋጃቸው ሰው ቢያገኙ ቀላል አይደለም። አረጋዊያን በመጨረሻ የህይወት ዘመናቸው በሃዘን እና በብቸኝነት እንደተቆረመዱ፤ ሁላችንም ወደማንቀርበት ቦታ እንዳይሄዱ የአቅማችንን በማድረግ፤ ፍቅር በማሳየት ተስፋቸው በጥቂቱም እንዲታደስ ከበሳ አድራጊ ሰው ጋር እናገናኛቸዋለን ። አንድ ነፍስ ለሌላ የነፍስ እንድትደርስ!

A LIFE OF DIGNITY

Most people, including the elderly, want their independence and would do anything to support themselves. No one wants or chooses to live on handouts. At the age of 96, Mr Z lives on his own and works hard to make ends meet. He is a traditional weaver, a proud man with unique skills and tenacity. However, due to ill-health and old age he struggles to make enough to pay for his basic needs.

Thanks to one of our private donor, who supplements his income, Mr Z's life has become that of hope and gratitude. Unsurprisingly, Mr Z got emotional when we asked him how he was getting on with life. He marvels, "how did a family I have never met before do this for me? RESPONSE IN A PANDEMIC

የአስቸኳይ ጊዜ እርዳታ

2020 was an exceptionally challenging year for many of us. Even in 2021, the Coronavirus has continued to impact on the way we live.

Although every community has been affected, some are more vulnerable than others. Efforts to contain the virus during the early days of the pandemic shocked the community that FICDO serves to the core. People needed to make a very hard choice between risking catching the virus by going out or going hungry by staying in. A climate of fear gripped the community. That was when FICDO started a pledge to collect donations to support the community. Thanks to your generous donations, throughout 2020 and early 2021 we could serve and save the lives of hundreds of people during those harsh times. Restrictions have since eased in 2021 and people have returned to work.

COMPASSION IN THE AGE OF COVID-19

When COVID-19 was first reported in Ethiopia, in March 2020, Rebecca Ewnetu was very much concerned for the children under FICDO's care. She was stricken by a photograph showing anxious children attempting to cover their mouth with their hands for fear of catching the virus. By then, little was known about the virus and what impact it would have on people of various age groups.



Rebecca teamed up with her school friend Olivia who had just set up a crafts business dedicated to hand making reusable face masks. Altogether the girls donated 120 euros worth of individually crafted masks which we then distributed to 30 children partaking in our education program.

We are greatly inspired by these two young girls' generosity and compassion. Let's remember that just as COVID-19 is contagious, so is compassion. How did you impact your "neighbor" today? Were you compassionate?

HEALTH CARE SERVICE

የጤና አገልግሎት

The Community Based Health Insurance (CBHI) scheme in Ethiopia is highly important as it aims to increase access to healthcare for the most destitute. It is heavily subsidized by the Government, with members expected to pay an annual premium of just seven euro per household. Unfortunately, even seven euro per annum can be too much to afford for the most vulnerable in our community. Taking this into account, FICDO has added "Health Care Service" as one of our core social inclusion projects. All elderly and children under FICDO's care are now covered. We thank our friends who stepped in to support this project.

Community mobilization is one of FICDO's core objectives. We started the year by holding a public consultation /community engagement event, during which key issues were identified and resourcing were discussed. Certificates were also handed to volunteers and key partners. We were encouraged by the various pledges, including a pledge by the community to cover the cost of the 2020/2021 academic year's stationery supply for all students in primary and secondary schools in the town. Seven representatives were also named during the gathering, to work with FICDO.

THE UNSUNG HEROES OF OUR COMMUNITY

Our community didn't disappoint when it came to keeping the pledge they had made at the beginning of the year! In addition to school materials, Salale University donated food supplies, footwear and 400m fabric worth 57,567 birr for the children's clothing. *Samson Furniture* - a local business - covered the cost of tailoring of the fabric. The association of business owners in Fitcha town donated food supplies (pasta, flour, oil and spices) towards our feeding program.



Several business owners and citizens made multiple one off donations in kind and cash. Half a dozen public servants signed up for monthly support despite the high cost of living and generally low wages they receive. Several volunteers, in addition to giving their valuable time, paid out of their own pocket to cover urgent expenses. Some rose early in the morning, throughout the year, to ensure breakfast was served to the children. We are inspired by these unsung heroes, and excited by the overwhelming support. This has encouraged us to hope for the best in the times ahead!

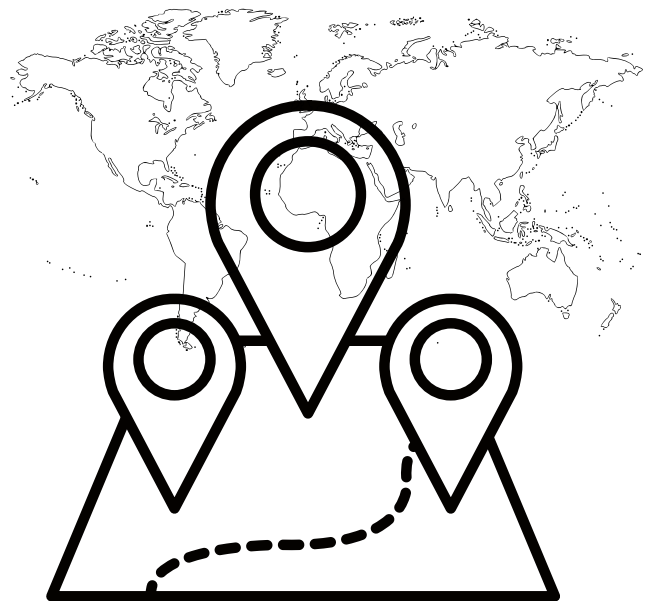


WHEN LOVE AND COMPASSION CROSS BOUNDARIES

Liffey Valley Vineyard (LVV) is a community church in Liffey Valley area, Dublin, Ireland. Compassion runs deep in the heart of this small community of faith, as witnessed by their action.

It was actually a heart for the vulnerable that brought LVV's Ann Marie and Seamus Kerr and FICDO's Ewnetu Ermias together for the first time as they met while volunteering in Dublin. Following that, in April 2020, when COVID-19 brought chaos to communities around the world, Ewnetu started a fundraising campaign to support those whose livelihoods have been impacted by measures taken to contain the pandemic in Fitchetown where FICDO operates.

LVV's donations helped several families get by during those tough times. Later in May 2020, the partnership grew into LVV supporting FICDO's social inclusion projects in Fitchetown. Since then, LVV has been a most valued partner.



Through LVV's support, FICDO has been able to not only reach out to the most vulnerable but to also empower and mobilize the local community in Fitchetown.

LVV's support to FICDO has a number of positive effects. The physical impact on the lives of the direct beneficiaries of FICDO's social inclusion projects is obvious. However, there are also enormous psycho-spiritual benefits. The beneficiaries are deeply touched when they realize that the support has been enabled by a small church in far away Ireland who shared their valuable resources for the sake of love. This same realization has also inspired FICDO's volunteers to work even harder and walk in love for their own community in Ethiopia. LVV's love and compassion surely has crossed all known barriers and boundaries to touch people on the other side of the world. In one of FICDO's volunteers own words, "we have preached and been preached to about love. The LVV folks have shown us how to live out love".

A PASSION TO SERVE

Interview with Zinash Mekonnen, founder and President of God's Mercy House (GMH)



Zinash Mekonnen is a Canadian originally from Ethiopia. Her organisation, GMH, is a ministry focused on supporting the most vulnerable members of communities (children and single mothers) in several regions in Ethiopia. GMH has been a valuable partner of FICDO for the last two years. Nuhamin Ermias from FICDO's media team has compiled an email interview with Zinash as follows:

FICDO: Tell us a little about yourself.

Zinash: I was born in Ethiopia and lived there for most of my young life. Although I am now living in Canada with my children and grand children, I still spend most of my time in Ethiopia, except the last two years when the pandemic made travel difficult.

FICDO: Tell us about GMH and how/why it was founded.

Zinash: GMH was founded and registered as non-profit in June 2009 in Canada. Before I came to Canada, I was a single-mother with two boys. Life can be quite hard for children and single-mothers in Ethiopia. I know that. It is even worse for young children who lost their parents to HIV and other diseases. So, I wanted to do something about that. Initially, I started helping just three children, then six and from there the numbers kept increasing. For several years, I simply shared the small resources I have had. After a couple of years, I got friends and partners. Today with the support of my two sons and several Canadian friends we are supporting hundreds of children and single-mothers in several regions in Ethiopia. (Continued to next page)

FICDO: How/why did you partner with FICDO?

Zinash: I always pray for God to lead me in my work. I have had this strong feeling for quite some time to expand GMH's ministry to the north (all GMH's work are concentrated in southern Ethiopia). The problem is I had never set foot to the north (of Addis) and had no knowledge of the region. One fateful day, an old friend [who happens to be FICDO's board chairman] asked me if I was interested on a 100km drive outside Addis to visit the work of a small charity (FICDO) that he was volunteering in. I agreed and we set a date for the journey. As we drove out of Addis, I asked him which part of Ethiopia the road is heading as it was all new to me. He replied, "to the north". [He knew nothing about my fascination with the north and long-held dream of expanding GMH's work to the north]. I was a bit emotional as I felt that that journey was an answer to my years of prayers.

Once we arrived at the town, I was moved by the deep poverty in which several elderly and children live. That was how it all started.

FICDO: what kind of support are you providing for FICDO now?

Zinash: initially, GMH started with sponsoring the cost of school uniforms since we did not have the budget. But the sight of those children never left my mind even after I went back to Canada. So I decided to pay from my personal savings towards the cost of meals for 16 children.

FICDO: how does that make you feel, reaching out to these children?

Zinash: I can't describe it in words. Even though what I am doing is not much, I know as a mother that it means so much to these children just to eat a meal a day.

FICDO: Any advice for our readers?

Zinash: Don't feel that you cannot have an impact, do what you can do. Your contribution matters!

FICDO: Advice for FICDO?

Zinash: Keep on doing what you are doing!

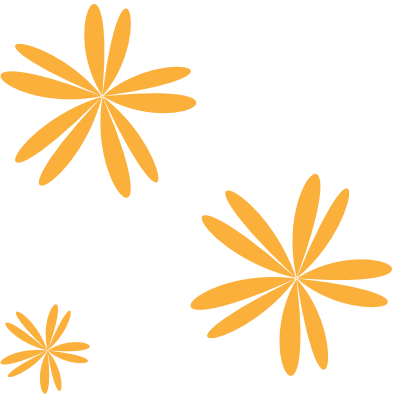

Critical Analysis of FICDO's Community Care

Critical Analysis of FICDO's Community Care

Disclaimer: This piece is my (Ewnetu Ermias) personal perspective. This reflection specifically focuses on community services that the FICDO has been providing since it started operating in June 2019. I will take personal responsibility for any unintended omissions or additions. Part of this essay has been presented recently to IBI/York St John University as academic work.

Introduction

Need and context are critically important in provision of care. The importance of context cannot be emphasized enough in FICDO's case - an organisation founded to "care for communities" in a region endowed by vast human and natural resources, and yet, ironically affected by deep-rooted poverty. In addition to poverty, the complex socio-economic and cultural settings in the area within which the organization operates demand a unique approach to community care. FICDO's care model also recognizes the African worldview that highly values community above individualism, without neglecting the uniqueness of an individual.

Within this context, community care in FICDO aims **"to nurture relationships, and support and impassion the community to care for each other. To demonstrate unconditional love, acceptance and encouragement for the whole community, particularly the most vulnerable, in a manner that glorifies God"**.

What is involved

As shown in Table 1 and 2, FICDO's care constitutes a wide range of care services that are hoped to lead towards healing, sustaining, guiding and reconciling care recipients. The services in Table 2 are particularly addressing the facilitation of growth-enabling environment in the community.

Table 1. Range of direct and indirect care available to vulnerable elderly and school-age children with no families

Type of care	What is involved/resources*
Psycho-spiritual support	Befriending (dubbed <i>Soul-2-Soul</i>) program aimed at providing company to lonely elderly
Practical day-to-day support	Help with domestic work
Monthly cash subsidy	Support to elderly in extreme economic circumstances (where a sponsor is not available, the organization allocates fixed amount for each care recipient)
Medical care	Government subsidized community-based insurance for elderly and schoolchildren (premiums paid by donations from the community)
Ready meals**	Community-run school feeding centre. - Children get daily meals before going to school - Volunteers bring meals from feeding centre to elderly suffering from extreme health and economic issues
School materials (stationery, uniforms) for children	Aimed at keeping children in school (Paid for by donations from community/supporters)

** Meals prepared by hired cooks, using resources donated by the community

Critical Analysis of FICDO's Community Care (Cont'd)

Underlying Beliefs and Framework

The key characteristics and underlying beliefs of FICDO's community care strategy include:

1. "Every member" care strategy

FICDO's care strategy seeks to include care into **the natural life of all people within communities**. The care services listed in Tables 1 and 2 require mobilization of every resource that is available. There is a recognition that everyone created in the image of a loving God can be useful to his/her neighbor in one way or another. We recognise that simple practical support can make a huge difference in another person's life. With this realization, the following statement appears under one of FICDO's core values as a clear commitment to encouraging "every member care strategy":

"We believe that everyone has something to offer; hence we will listen."

The model encourages everyone in the community to view themselves as caregivers and participate in community care according to their gifts and interests. Areas volunteers can be engaged in include, but are not limited to, one-to-one care for elderlies in their own homes (befriending), volunteering in community feeding centres, taking part in multilingual campaigning and awareness creation, training others, supporting the work financially and through prayer. All caregivers are obliged to adhere to the organization's core values - love, hope, humility, integrity, courage, respect and inclusiveness. An oversight committee meets weekly via zoom, for mutual encouragement, formative reflections, review progress and provide directions.

2. Compassion

FICDO's community care model is designed to respond to human pain and struggle with understanding, compassion and grace. We take seriously the socio-economic dimensions of life as experienced by the impoverished and most vulnerable in the community.

While each life stage has its own challenges, developmental crises can increase the vulnerability of children and the elderly. These groups are particularly dependent on others for survival and could be exposed to rampant poverty if they don't have immediate/extended family members who may care for them. Thus, FICDO's care for these vulnerable groups is a compassionate response to their needs for warmth, nurturing support and caring.

3. Emphasis on Transformation

Beyond support during crises, FICDO's care aims at transformation, generating hope and growth in love for both caregivers and receivers.

"Giving" is often associated with physical/financial resources and regarded as something the "resource-rich" would engage in. However, acts of kindness such as "giving time" to listen to, or be with someone, checking up on a lonely neighbor and helping with domestic work, which do not require material/financial resources are equally important. These simple acts can make significant differences in the lives of many people, especially lonely elderly. Thus, by strongly emphasizing on "being with" rather than "doing for", large sections of the community who feel "inadequate" to contribute to the well-being of their community for lack of resources can be empowered. As a clear commitment to this empowerment, statements like the following are included in FICDO's core values and campaigns:

- *"We believe that a loving heart is what it takes to serve others and transform lives"*
- *"We believe that everyone has something to offer; hence we will listen."*

For the resource-rich in the community, too, FICDO provides organised platform to reach out to their compatriots. Hence, the care model creates new possibilities by sparking a new way of thinking and doing for both resource-poor and resource-rich in the community. It allows proactive nurturing, and the facilitation of caring environments within which people can grow and develop to their fullest potential.

4. Pro-active Care

Working towards prevention (pro-active care) of problems/issues is usually preferable than reacting when they happen. In a number of places, community relations are deteriorating partly due to lack of/poor communication. FICDO's care model aspires towards transformation/nurturing of community relations. Experience from around the world show that volunteering and partaking in activities can bring together people, who otherwise would have no chance to come together. This can open up conversations that make people learn about each other and be aware of each other's physical, spiritual, emotional and practical needs. In FICDO's context, bringing volunteers from different faith and ethnic groups, who often see each other with suspicion, together for a common cause can nurture relationships and prevent/minimize tensions. Community care in terms of sensitization regarding peaceful co-existence and Godly- living, and the provision of a platform to care for each other are major investments towards achieving "shalom" in our communities.

Critical Analysis of FICDO's Community Care (Cont'd)

5. Putting "Love" at Center-stage of care

In FICDO, everything is about "love". The emphasis on "love" is so much that even FICDO's name '*Fikir*' literally translates to "love" in one of Ethiopia's national language. Love takes centre-stage as there is no better way to imitate a loving God, than leading a life of love.

The reason "love" is an organizational mantra is also to highlight the motivations behind the organization's work and emphasize the transformational power of care rooted in love. The following statements appear in the organization's core values:

- "We are motivated by love to serve others before ourselves"
- "We have high hopes that love can transform those who give and receive."

FICDO's communication strategy also stipulates the use of "terminologies" that pays special attention to *love* in the organization's work. Whatever caregivers do in their caring duty (giving time, donating in kind or cash), it is referred to as a "gift of love". This is to emphasize the **motive rather than the task and/or the material** that is exchanged as a gift. Furthermore, caregivers are encouraged to refer to their tasks as "giving/receiving love".

6. Respect and Inclusiveness

FICDO's community care model strives to be inclusive and respectful by embracing anyone who would want to serve. This has been affirmed in the core values as well as practically involving volunteers in all aspects of care. However, given that FICDO serves a multi-faith community and our caregivers hail from diverse backgrounds, FICDO's care policy strongly advises caregivers to exercise caution and wisdom and not to use the platform to proselytize. i.e. caregivers are strongly advised to respect the care-recipients' choices and rights. As the old adage goes, "action speaks louder than words"; so we believe "love in action" speaks louder and, hence, encourage everyone to rather live their faith in practice. On the other hand, we don't hide, for the sake of political correctness, the fact that we are inspired by our faith in God to do what we are doing. After all, our entire community, one way or another, has faith in God.

The inclusion of love, humility and respect in FICDO's core values is also to ensure both care-recipients and caregivers get due respect. When discussing care-recipients, one critical issue comes to the forefront: the manner in which care recipients are viewed. FICDO's care policy strictly prohibits the use of any kind of demeaning language such as "needy" when referring to care recipients. Even the term "beneficiary" is not used to refer to care recipients as a way of recognizing that everyone in the community (including the caregiver) benefits when one person is cared for. We believe that caring in love is partnering with God, who unconditionally loves and actively works in the life of the care recipient.

There are many reasons for a caregiver to walk in humility when caring for others. First we recognize that we are just like the one we reach out to care for. It is one needy person reaching out to another. Honest personal reflection on this reality helps caregivers maintain a posture of humility. Second and most importantly, we believe that God is there and working in the hurting person seeking our help and we are there "to cooperate".

FICDO's advocacy and awareness creation/community sensitization campaigns (see Table 2) ensure respect, dignity and well-being of senior citizens. Active campaigns on social media (in multiple languages) address not only the challenges the elderly face but also highlight their legacies and their potential contribution to society (as living libraries of wisdom). These campaigns aim to bring changes in attitudes and behaviors towards the elderly.

7. Recognizing Limitations

At FICDO, we recognize that we do not have "all the answers" and we cannot "fix" all problems. That is why the emphasis, especially in the befriending program, is "*being with*" than "*doing for*". Although resources are shared to save lives in extreme cases, being present with, listening to and journeying alongside care recipients are what the care model emphasizes. Showing genuine interest and listening to the stories of those being cared for is a powerful support one can give and FICDO is trying to do just that.

In a nutshell,

FICDO's community care model is relevant and contextual:

- It takes into account the African worldview where a communal way of living supersedes individualism, without neglecting the uniqueness of individuals.
- It brings back care to the community itself, to understand their needs and perspectives.
- It takes the socio-economic dimensions of life as experienced by the poor and vulnerable and builds care around these by:
 - 1) addressing their critical needs, and
 - 2) enabling and empowering those that "disqualify" themselves from serving others because of lack of material resources
- It is inclusive, mobilizing and pooling all resources in the community.
- It sheds a ray of hope and nurtures relationships by bringing together community members from various ethnic groups, political and religious views, for a shared goal.
- It embeds proactive-care, self-awareness, respect, humility and reflective practice
- It respects local cultures, norms and beliefs

Weaknesses

Although FICDO's community care model is relevant and contextual, it is far from perfect:

The deep-rooted poverty in the community FICDO is operating adversely affects the quality and provision of care in two ways:

- It necessitates the prioritization of meeting the physical needs of care recipients that are in extreme conditions, overshadowing the need for deep psycho-spiritual and sustainable development, and rendering the care to a mere provision of physical/material support. While FICDO's care model looks good on paper, the reality on the ground is far more challenging requiring patience, time and resources.
- Overwhelming conditions exposing to risk: Feedback from majority of caregivers engaged in *Soul-2-Soul* befriending program indicate that caregivers hardly contain their emotions as the conditions in which the elderly care recipients live are overwhelming. Most caregivers admitted having resorted to drawing from their personal resources to cover urgent needs of care recipients, as "they could not look away and do nothing". While such help may be done with insight and the ability to discern wisely, our volunteer caregivers bear the brunt of the burden. This may expose them to the risk of unintended suffering, eventually leading to disillusionment, burnout or "compassion fatigue". Even when FICDO's policy strongly encourages for self and other awareness and the realization of personal limitations to safeguard against what many call "dangers" in care, the risks remain high because of the reality on the ground.

Issues inherent in the very foundation of the organization could also expose it to various risks impacting the quality and provision of care.

- Over-reliance on donations means, the sustainability of some of the care packages such as direct financial subsidy to the elderly cannot be guaranteed. If our volunteer caregivers fail to adequately communicate and set clear expectations,
 - It may create unwanted dependency (although this becomes irrelevant with regard to the elderly care-recipients who have zero income and thus remain totally dependent on handouts).
 - The reliability and integrity of the organisation and/or the volunteer caregivers may come into question when the level of care cannot be maintained.
- Over-reliance on volunteers: The nature of volunteering makes planning difficult since commitment cannot be fully guaranteed. This can impact the quality of care by adversely affecting the reliability and integrity of the organization and its care services. Furthermore, where there is a shortage of volunteer caregivers, the few most dedicated volunteers would be burdened to keep the service going. This could result in burnout.

Conclusion and Recommendations

Models of care that are individualistic cannot adequately cope with the systemic, cultural and psychological dimensions of the contextual needs of care recipients in the community FICDO is operating. Thus, FICDO's community care strategy rightly involves community mobilization as a pragmatic real-life effort towards minimizing the suffering of the most vulnerable. The care model is fairly comprehensive with strong evidence of reflective practice. However, the overall strategy has inherent weaknesses that may expose it to risks that could adversely affect the quality and provision of care by the organization. Hence, the following are recommended to minimize the risks:

- While the embedding of caring within the community is important, over-reliance on donations can expose to major operational and reputational risks. Hence, the organization may need to look into other options such as ways of generating permanent income. Until permanent income generation is in place, the organisation may need to consider concentrating on the provision of care services that could bring significance to care recipients' lives without requiring extensive financial resources.
- Sustainable and meaningful work and timely reporting, as required by law, may be hampered without a dedicated permanent staff. Hence, it is recommended that at least one full-time permanent staff be hired although this may pose extra resource challenge on the organisation.
- While setting expectations and clarifying the purpose and nature of the care are critical at all times, support in terms of direct cash subsidy may need to be reviewed. When cash is involved, there is a potential for misunderstanding. Thus, an alternative approach that may not involve cash may need to be further investigated.
- Reflection and support at core-group /oversight committee/ level is strong and should be continued. However, there is a strong need for a planned approach to support and train volunteer caregivers who are interacting with the community. Training should cover self- and other-awareness, limitations, the need for setting expectations and boundaries, self-care and other measures that safeguard against dangers in care. The painful situations that some care-recipients live can be disheartening and can be overwhelming for caregivers. Thus, time and effort should be invested in equipping caregivers in terms of emotional growth and an awareness that can protect them from unintended and unnecessary suffering in the process of helping others.
- In addition to training and creating awareness on self-care, the organization should enforce a system (for example rota) that will allow volunteers to take breaks and recharge.
- A clear vision statement and care and mobilization policy with a strong conflict management framework should be in place given that diverse groups are embraced to provide care. Such systems and procedures not only handle conflict appropriately, but also enable robust and fruitful collaboration among different stakeholders.
- Emphasis need to be given on campaigns in all local languages, especially Afaan Oromo, as it is the dominant language spoken in the community.
